FOUNDATION DESIGN OF KAVI SUBHASH METRO STATION FLAWLESS


In this context to the notice of Metro Railway authorities that certain statements have been made in some sections of the media regarding the foundation design of Kavi Subhash Metro Station, suggesting to be of shallow or raft foundation type with a depth of 1-3 metres, Metro Railway would like to clarify that this information is not correct. The foundation of Kavi Subhash Metro Station has been constructed using deep pile foundations extending up to 22 metres, arranged in pile groups comprising 2 to 4 piles. All design decisions are based on detailed geotechnical investigations following established engineering standards to ensure structural integrity and passenger safety. Metro Railway appreciates public interest in infrastructure development and welcomes informed deliberations.

HOWRAH DIVISION CONDUCTED RAILWAY CAMP COURT TO CURB TICKETLESS TRAVEL

In a proactive initiative to curb ticketless travel and ensure a seamless journey experience for genuine passengers, a Railway Camp Court was successfully conducted today at Howrah Station under the aegis of Howrah Division, Eastern Railway. The Special Camp Court, presided over by the Railway Magistrate, was set up in the old premises of Howrah Station. The initiative aimed to promote lawful travel by swiftly addressing cases of irregular travel. It sent a strong message to ticketless travellers and reinforced the Division's unwavering commitment to upholding railway rules and ensuring passenger safety. The Special Camp Court held on 31.07.2025 generated a total earning of Rs. 6,77,000/-, which included Rs. 2,82,630/- collected from 581 passengers penalised for travelling without or with irregular tickets, Rs. 19,300/- collected from 188 passengers for unbooked luggage and Rs. 44,840/- realised from 158 cases presented before the Railway Magistrate, which also included 64 cases booked by Ticket Examiners amounting to Rs. 16,640/- . Special attention was given to Divyang (differently-abled), ladies, and vendor compartments, ensuring inclusivity and safety across all sections of the train.

SER Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi, today has approved (Four) projects of Ministry of Railways with total cost of Rs. 11,169 crore (approx.).

These projects include: 1)Dangopoo-Jaroli 3rd and 4th Line, 2) Aurangabad (Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj - Parbhani) Doubling, 3) Akazari Road-New Jalpaiguri 4th and 4th Line, 4th Line 'A' Nagpur 4th Line Dangopoo-Jaroli 3rd and 4th line project of South Eastern Railway. The total estimated cost is Rs 1,752 Cr. This project connects the iron ore area and steel production units of Kendujhar district, Odisha & West Singhbhum district, Jharkhand. After completion, the project will play a crucial role in meeting target of 300-million-ton annual steel production. Details of project: Route length: 43 km and track length: 108 km 7 stations, 10 major bridges, 196 minor bridges, 8 RBGs, 4 RUBs, 2 Rail over rail bridges will save 3.85 Cr fire diesel. Will save 170 Cr of cost. (equal to planting 11 Cr trees) Will facilitate 50 million tons of cargo. Will save Rs 6.038 Cr in logistics cost.

BIRLA CORPORATION JUNE QUARTER NET PROFIT UP 26.4%, EBITDA UP 38%

Birla Corporation Ltd. recorded a consolidated revenue of Rs 2,466 or for the June quarter, up 13% over last year, & delivered a net profit of Rs 200 crore, up 25.4% year-on-year. Sales by volume for the quarter grew 9%. The Company's consolidated EBITDA grew 38% to Rs 379 or from Rs 275 or in the same period last year. The growth in EBITDA was the result of improved cement sales, lower operating cost and a turnaround in July. The Company's cement sales by volume during the quarter was at 4.79 million tons (mt) compared to 4.38 mt in the same period last year. Cement sales were affected by early arrival of the monsoon and depressed prices in some of the Company's core markets in central India. The Company experienced mixed market conditions in different regions of operations. While the western & eastern markets were relatively buoyant, price & demand in central India remained muted.


